This team goes into the community in our SCS van to build relationships, trust and support.

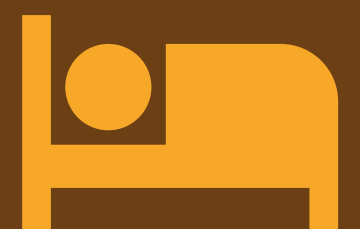
